MHMRTC is offering a comprehensive evaluation to teenagers (13-18) with substance abuse problems who are also experiencing problems with attention and concentration (symptoms of Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)) through a nation-wide study that provides eligible adolescents the opportunity to receive specialized treatment for their substance abuse and either medication for their ADHD or placebo (sugar pill).

All participants will receive substance abuse treatment at no cost through individual Cognitive Behavioral Therapy sessions, and will also be compensated for their time and travel.
